Matthew 9:20-22

20. Then suddenly from behind him came a woman who had been suffering from a hemorrhage for twelve years,

And she touched the fringe of his tunic,

21. for she was thinking, 'If only I can touch his tunic, I will be saved.'

22. Jesus turned round and saw her; and he said to her 'Courage, my daughter; your faith has saved you.'

And from that hour the woman was saved.

hemorrhage

Mark 5:25-34

25. Now there was a woman who had suffered from a hemorrhage for twelve years. 26. having endured much under many physicians, she had spent all that she had, without getting any benefit from it; in fact she was getting worse. 27. She had heard about Jesus and came up through the crowd and touched his tunic from behind thinking, 28. 'If I can just touch his clothes, I shall be saved.' 29. At once the source of the bleeding dried up, and she felt in her body that she cured of her sickness. 30. and at once aware of the power that had gone out from him, Jesus turned around in the crowd and said, 'Who touched my clothes?' 31. His disciples said to him, 'You see how the crowd is jostling you; how can you say, 'Who touched me?' 32. but he began looking round to see who had done it. 33. Then the woman came forward in fear and trembling, because she knew what had happened to her, and *she fell before him* and told him the whole truth. 34. And he said to her, 'My daughter, your faith has saved you; go in peace, and be free of your sickness.'

The Gerasene Demoniac

Mark 5:1-20

1. They reached the territory of the Gerasenes on *the other side of the lake*,

2. **a man** with an unclean spirit at once came out of the tombs towards him.

7. *He fell at his feet*

10. *He begged him earnestly* not to send them out of the district.

15. They came to Jesus and saw the demoniac - in his right mind and **they were afraid**.

17. They began to **implore Jesus to leave the neighbourhood**.

18. The man who had been possessed *begged* to be allowed to stay with him.

19. Jesus said, 'Go home to your people and **tell them all that the Lord in his mercy has done for you.**'

20. **The man proclaimed (the news)**. *And everyone was amazed.*

Jairus' Daughter

Mark 5:21-43

21. When Jesus had crossed again in the boat to *the other side*

A large crowd gathered around him and he *stayed by the lake*.

22. Then one of the **leaders of synagogue officials** named Jairus came up.

and seeing him, *fell at his feet*,

23. and *pleaded with him repeatedly* saying 'My little daughter is at the point of death.'

33. then the woman, came forward in fear and trembling ... *she fell before him* and told him the whole truth.

40. but they **ridiculed** him.

42. At once the little girl got up ... they were *overcome with astonishment*,

and he gave **strict orders that no one should know about it**.
